Steve opened the meeting and welcomed those in attendance.

Steve made a motion to accept the minutes as written on 4/19/2022 Brandi

The ATV Club is applying for a Municipal grant and needed the signatures
from the Selectboard.

Franklin Savings bank is now going to start charging us fees monthly. \$125

Rachel will call Skowhegan Savings Bank and see what the fees would be for
us and if we would be able to scan our checks in like we do now for Franklin
Savings Bank.

and will be on a first come first serve basis. Rachel will make up a map of the
banners and what pole number they are on.

Summer Rec is still looking for a Bus Driver. Shawn Niles spoke and said he
will try and help, Millie will talk to Hope and possibly Steve from CVA and
see if they can come to an agreement on pay.

New plan made for the dumping on the septic fields at the Transfer Station.
There will be a spread sheet they need to fill out to keep track of what is
being dumped and in what field.

Town is getting ready to put out for quotes for the well at the Transfer Station. He has come up with a list of what he wants the quotes to be based on. That needs to be done soon to have water there for the summer.

Peter said he is waiting on 2 more quotes for construction for the Food Pantry expansion.

Peter has been working with the planning Board for a rezoning of the Area around Tranquility Inn to limited commercial. Grant Cove will stay the same. It will need to go to a special town meeting after the Planning board is done.
