WHEN: The 8-week program starts June 26th and runs through August 17th, Monday-Thursday, from 8 am to 3pm.

WHERE: Drop off will be at Stratton School daily at 8am (unless your child is eating breakfast, then 7:30) at 8:15 they will depart the school and go to Cathedral Pines beach. Pick up will be at the Cathedral Pines Pavilion (Just as you enter the campground) @ 3pm. Please be on time when picking up your child. On rainy days the kids will be staying at the school, community building or Masonic lodge. Updates will be posted on Facebook and communicated to you by a program counselor.

WHAT TO BRING: Each child should bring a backpack w/ plenty of water, snacks, a swimsuit, towel, appropriate clothing, sunscreen, and bug spray. Clothing and anything else in the backpack should be clearly marked with their name. As well as anything needed for the day's activities.

BREAKFAST/LUNCH PROGRAM: Free breakfast will be served from 7:30am – 8:00am at Stratton School. Kids who eat breakfast each morning must be supervised by their parents & lunch will be offered during our summer program., Please pack water and snacks for your child.
