Steve called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

Tim made a motion to accept the minutes from the meeting on May 12, 2026, as written Carol 2<sup>nd</sup> Steve, Tim, Jeff, Linda, & Carol in favor Motion passed unanimously.

**New Business:**

6<sup>th</sup> Grade class learning about Civics and Government. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade class discussed food sovereignty. Where does it come from? We need to protect our small farms and food producers. They gave a packet for the select board to review.

Steve made a motion to accept Scrib's excavation for a 10% increase in price for the 3-year plow contract for 26-29 for \$77,000 per year, Jeff 2<sup>nd</sup> Steve, Tim, Jeff, Linda, & Carol in favor Motion passed unanimously.

Steve made a motion to accept Absolut Services for a 10% price increase for the 3-year plow contract for 26-29 for \$8,250 for the plowing of the Transfer Station, Tim 2<sup>nd</sup> Steve, Tim, Jeff, Linda, & Carol in favor Motion passed unanimously.

A few companies have inquired about road grading. John will get the scope of work put together for the work. Rachel then will get the bid package together to go out to bid. It's 2.57 miles of road that needs to be graded.

Is calcium on dusty roads an option? The Transfer Station needs it bad. John would like to make sure we are good on the runoff from the road to the water before we do anything.

**Old Business:**

The No Parking issue. The town must have an ordinance for no parking for it to be enforced. The Planning Board will need to create the ordinance. Steve would like to see what we can do. We have spent a good amount of funds on the sidewalks and do not want them ruined.

**Selectboard Updates:**

Mark Thibodeau, REGenerate will take all the logs from the Transfer Station from now on. They will look this fall to see if it is worth coming then to get the logs or wait until Spring of 2027.

Carol said the food pantry now has a new exhaust fan installed in the food pantry room.

**Department Head Updates:**

The rat issue is better, but a few are still hanging around. Still working on the issue. Possible it is under trash canister.

Discussion on adjustments to the Transfer Station Bathroom. Finalizing details of the project.

Working on roof quotes. New credit card company started today. Govt. Window
